

Who are they

Since 1989, Corgom srl re-treads, reconstructs and sells tires.

In the last decade, they grew up to integrate three main activities: collection, restoration and recycling of the exhausted tyres.

These activities are nowadays managed by producers and importers consortiums, taking to excellent results. For instance, they are ensuring the disposal of irregularly piled up exhausted tyres in many portions of the Italian country.

Re-treaded tyres

They re-tread tyres by changing the old tread with a new one, very similar to the original features. Every used tyre, that has not undergone to structural changes, can be re-treaded.

There are two different re-treading techniques: *hot* and *cold*. Re-treading your tyre will give it a new life.




First Crushing

The ELT is introduced on a rotating shear that performs a first cold crushing of the material, the tire in turn is reduced into fragments between 5 and 40 cm called "slippers" or "shredded".



Second Crushing

Through a second crushing phase, the material is further reduced into smaller fragments and divided, by physical or mechanical procedures, into the three main components of which ELTs are made: rubber, steel and textile fibers.



Safeguarding the environment

Corgom environmental commitment is carefully kept. They believe that coming generations should live in a healthy and less polluted planet. It is difficult, but necessary as well.

Their company respects the environmental laws for the disposal of exhausted tyres, which cannot be considered normal waste.

Tyres cannot be left down on the streets nor on the public land. This is a criminal offence and is punished with appropriate laws.

0 - 0.8 mm.

0.8 - 2.5 mm.

2 - 4 mm.
